6th Asian Indoor and Martial Arts Games Selection Criteria, Minimum Requirements, Selection Mechanism, Appeal Mechanism and Timeline for Nomination Procedures set by Hong Kong, China Tenpin Bowling Congress Limited

Introduction

6th Asian Indoor and Martial Arts Games (6th AIMAG) is schedule to be held in Bangkok, Thailand from November 19-30, 2024. The Bowling Competition's events include Singles, Doubles, Team of 4 and All Events. A maximum of 4 athletes will be selected for the Men Team.

Selection Criteria and Minimum Requirement

1. Current HKSI Full Time Athlete
2. Ranked 1st-8th in 2023 IBF World Championships
3. Take part in the Selection Mechanism

Selection Mechanism

We will select the team based on the subjective criteria, objective criteria (Multi Sports Games/ Official Championships results from 2021-2024) and performance results in below events:

1. Average Score in 2022 & 2023 Thailand International Open (Same bowling center for 6th Asian Indoor and Martial Arts Games)
2. Average Score in 2024 Macau China International Open Bowling Championships (June 24-30, 2024) & 47th Hong Kong International Open (June 30-July 6, 2024)

Subjective criteria

Physical Game, which includes, but is not limited to, the many physical elements that comprise an athlete's game, such as approach, arm swing, timing, release versatility (changing rotation and ball landing target point) and speed control. It also includes, but is not limited to, the ability to play different angles, shoot spares, change equipment and adjust to different lane conditions;

Mental Game, which includes a variety of subjective factors such as coachability, adaptability, practice regimen, ability to stay focused, attitude, commitment, ability to perform under pressure and sportsmanship.

Team Play, which includes, but is not limited to, the intangible, but crucial ability to be a positive factor in building rapport, confidence, and a winning attitude among the team members and coaches.

Appeal Mechanism

Appeal against the non-selection may be made in writing in email to the Chairman and HKCTBC by **July 10, 2024, on or before 12 pm.** The sole ground for any appeal is that the selection criteria is not properly followed. Within two (2) working days of receiving the appeal, the Appeal Committee will investigate the issues of the appeal with all involved parties. HKCTBC will, in writing, inform all parties about the Appeal Committee's decision to either uphold or reject the appeal by **July 12, 2024.** The decision of the Appeal Panel will be final.

Deadline for Submitting Accreditation Application to SF&OC and design of competition uniform for Protocol approval	July 17, 2024

SF&OC 3 rd Selection Committee Meeting	Mid July 2024
Review on NSAs nomination by SF&OC Selection Committee	Late July 2024
Official Deadline for SF&OC to submit entries to 6 th AIMAG Organizing Committee	August 15, 2024
Training period for 6 th AIMAG	July 22, 2024 – November 18, 2024. The 27 th Asian Tenpin Bowling Championships is in September in the same centre in Thailand. This championship is also the qualifying for the IBF World Championships to be held in Hong Kong in November 2025
6 th AIMAG	November 19 - 30, 2024

Other Points to note:

Change of Selected Athletes

An Athlete selected for the 6th AIMAG may be deselected at any point if the athlete:

1. Due to illness or injury becomes unable to perform to the required standard in the opinion of Chairman/Head Coach
2. Demonstrates a lack of commitment to training requirement and tournament preparation in the opinion of Chairman/Head Coach
3. Breaches or fails to fulfill the requirement of the Anti-Doping Policies of Anti-Doping Organization of Hong Kong, China/ IBF/ABF
4. Any other reason not stated above, but where change of selected athletes is deemed appropriate and approved by HKCTBC Selection Committee and SF&OC
