The HKCTBC Selection Committee is charged with selecting those athletes who are most likely to create the strongest HK, China Team. It has the latitude to consider any qualifications and criteria that it believes would be helpful in creating the strongest team based on the followings:

Performance, which includes all international competitions as well as any HKCTBC local tournaments within the previous three years;

Physical Games, which includes but is not limited to, the many physical elements that comprise an athlete's game, such as the approach, arm swing, timing, release versatility (changing rotation and target point) and speed control. It also includes, but is not limited to, the ability to play different angles, shoot spares, change equipment and adjust to different lane conditions;

Mental Game, which includes a variety of subjective factors such as, ability to stay focus, ability to control arousal level and ability to perform under pressure;

Attitude, which includes coachability, practice regimen, commitment and dedication, sportsmanship and how the athlete affects or influences other athletes and

Team Play, which includes, but is not limited to, the intangible, but crucial ability to be a positive factor in building rapport, confidence and winning attitude among the team members and coaches.

Selection Procedure

The HK, China National Team includes all those senior elite athletes who are full time and are under Elite A, B and C Category of the Hong Kong Sports Institute. The rest of the athletes receiving full-time or part-time ETG funding are members of the National Squad.

The HK, China National Youth Team are based on the same criteria as the senior team. Junior athletes receiving part-time ETG funding are members of the Youth Development Squad. The Youth Development Squad comes from Talent Identification and the Feeder System.
